



## Friday January 19 & Saturday January 20, 2018

We will send out detailed schedules as things are finalized with registrations. Here are a couple of general timing things:

- Friday night activities will all take place at the 20th Ave. YMCA from 5-9pm. This will include registration; pizza & salad dinner; a 30 minute instrument play-in & introductions; play time in gyms, Family Prime Time, climbing wall; and snacks. The actual play-in and clinician meet-and-greet will take place from 6:00-6:30 with registration and dinner beforehand and play time afterwards.
- All of Saturday's activities will be at Lourdes Academy in Oshkosh, not the Administration/Suzuki Building.
- Saturday will begin with assigned master classes at 8:00am and 9:00am. (Master classes provide students with the dual opportunities to play a polished piece for one of the clinicians, receiving specific one-on-one mastery tips as well as hear 2-3 other students perform. Master classes are one hour long, on Saturday, and are in addition to the 3 group lessons included in the Workshop fee. Master Class fee is \$40 for both OSMP students as well as for Guest students.) The remainder of the morning will be a variety of group classes and activities for students based on age and playing level.
- There will be a parent Q&A "class" for our clinician panel to give some tips as well as answer parent questions on practice, lessons, repertoire, etc. During this time there will be Chamber Music class for older students and a Music and Movement class for the younger students.
- Saturday lunch will be a soup, salad and sandwich bar for \$8. Snacks will also be sold throughout the day.
- Immediately following Saturday lunch, we will showcase the talents of our clinicians and OSMP faculty with 30 minute faculty & clinician recital.
- The remainder of the afternoon will continue with group lessons and master classes.
- We would also like to wrap up the Workshop with something new this year: a Super-Brief-All-Instrument-One-Piece Recital at the end of the day. We have a special piece that each group will work on during certain group lesson times on Saturday. Altogether, we're going to have a chance to show off hard work and talents to parents, each other and ourselves before packing it up and heading home by 5:00pm.
